

Financial Aid Withdrawal/Refund Policy

Financial Aid Withdrawal Policy

Financial aid is awarded on a semester basis. If a student withdraws from the semester for which they are awarded.

Financial aid is awarded on a semester basis. If a student withdraws from the semester for which they are awarded, the aid will be prorated based on the percentage of the semester completed. The percentage of the semester completed is calculated as follows: $\frac{\text{Number of classes completed}}{\text{Total number of classes in the semester}} \times 100\%$. If a student withdraws during the first 30% of the semester, the aid will be 100% refunded. If a student withdraws during the next 30% (30-60%), the aid will be 75% refunded. If a student withdraws during the next 30% (60-90%), the aid will be 50% refunded. If a student withdraws during the last 10% (90-100%), the aid will be 25% refunded.

College Refund Policy

Financial aid is awarded on a semester basis. If a student withdraws from BCC during the Drop/Add period in any given semester, the aid will be 100% refunded without penalty. Withdrawal Procedures

BCC recognizes that circumstances beyond a student's control may necessitate withdrawal from student. If a student withdraws from the semester for which they are awarded, the aid will be prorated based on the percentage of the semester completed. The percentage of the semester completed is calculated as follows: $\frac{\text{Number of classes completed}}{\text{Total number of classes in the semester}} \times 100\%$. If a student withdraws during the first 30% of the semester, the aid will be 100% refunded. If a student withdraws during the next 30% (30-60%), the aid will be 75% refunded. If a student withdraws during the next 30% (60-90%), the aid will be 50% refunded. If a student withdraws during the last 10% (90-100%), the aid will be 25% refunded.

Post withdrawal disbursement

If a student withdraws from a course, they may be eligible for a post-withdrawal disbursement. If this disbursement is made, the student will receive the funds within 10 business days.

Eligibility

Students who are currently receiving financial aid and who have completed the financial aid process are eligible for a post-withdrawal disbursement. Students who are no longer covered by their aid are not eligible.
